Name of Course/Course Code: AMI 10A (Grade 9 Instrumental Music)

Course Prerequisite: N/A

Course Description:

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience and is aimed at developing technique, sensitivity, and imagination. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop an understanding of the conventions and elements of music and of safe practices related to music.
