Name of Course/Course Code: AMI 20A (Grade 10 Instrumental Music)

Course Prerequisite: AMI 10A (Grade 9 Instrumental Music)

Course Description:

This course emphasizes the creation and performance of music at a level consistent with previous experience. Students will develop musical literacy skills by using the creative and critical analysis processes in composition, performance, and a range of reflective and analytical activities. Students will develop their understanding of musical conventions, practices, and terminology and apply the elements of music in a range of activities. They will also explore the function of music in society with reference to the self, communities, and cultures.

Students continue to develop their sense of self, and respect for self and the dignity and welfare of others, by being part of a performance group. They gain valuable insight into the meaning of being an effective and contributing interdependent team member who exercises leadership in the achievement of individual and group goals.
