Name of Course/Course Code: AMV10/20/3M/4M (Vocal Music)

Course Prerequisite: AMV10/20/3M

Course Description:

This course emphasizes the performance of music at a level that strikes a balance between challenge and skill. It is aimed at developing technique, sensitivity, and imagination in singing. Students will participate in creative activities that will teach them to listen with musical understanding and appreciation. Students will also learn correct musical terminology and its appropriate use. This course consists of the development of vocal technique through both solo and choral music.
