Name of Course/Course Code: English, Grade 10 Applied, ENG 2P

Course Prerequisite: ENG 1P

Course Description:

This course is designed to improve oral communication, reading, writing and media literacy skills that students need for success in their secondary school programs and in their daily lives. Students will analyse a variety of texts, interpret and evaluate informational and graphic texts, and create oral, written, and media texts in a variety of forms. An important focus will be on the selective use of strategies that contribute to effective communication, including preparation for the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test.
